

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Community Members,

Students at Ogden Middle School performed near or above the state averages in math and language arts on standards-based tests in 2015-16. In our second year of SBAC testing, we were able to gain information about individual student growth by comparing progress between the two years. While the number of students "meeting or exceeding" is an important measure, we were able to measure student growth from one year to the next for the first time. The data indicates the vast majority of Ogden students improved their scores from 2014-15 to 2015-16.

Academic highlights also include:

62.5% met/exceeded state reading standards

69% met/exceeded state science standards

Two areas to improve include math in general and the difference between certain groups of Ogden students. We will improve student

achievement in these areas by developing a more inclusive teaching model for math and language arts classes emphasizing differentiated instruction for each student. And we will make in-class assessment data the focus of team meetings to benefit individuals as well as groups of students. Our aim continues to be individual academic and social growth of our students. You can help by monitoring ParentVue, attending parent teacher conferences and/or volunteering. Our continued partnership in 2016-17 will ensure our commitment to provide a safe, respectful, responsible learning community where all students progress socially and academically.

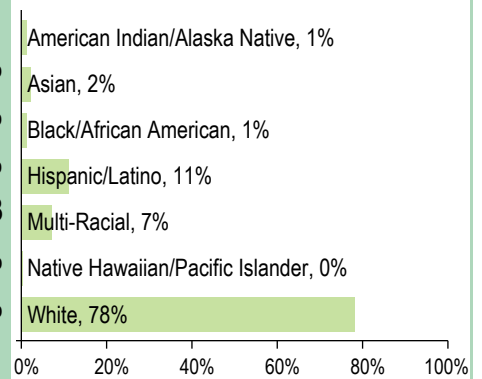

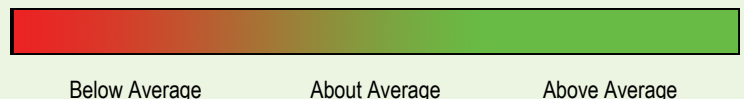
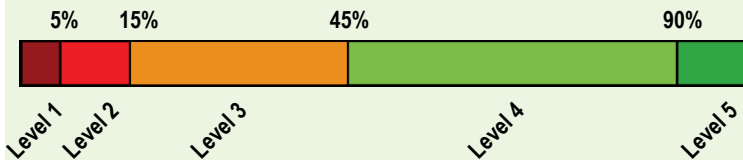
